Description: Wander the parkland that is the south flank of Mt. Baker.

This trips features: A creek crossing; a suspension bridge; spectacular views of Baker, Blum, Shuksan and the North Cascades; endless possibilities for wanderings in the high alpine meadows; a possible riot of wild flowers; looks at the snout of the Easton Glacier and oh, so much more. We will do the loop clockwise in order to cross Rocky Creek before the afternoon melt.

A refreshment stop on return should be anticipated with the concurrence of the group. A Northwest Forest Pass is required at the trailhead.

Please note, prior registration through the S'no Joke ClubExpress website is required and group size will be limited to a maximum of 12 persons.

Directions: Drive Highway 20 east from Sedro Woolley to +- MP 82. Shortly past MP 82 turn left on Baker Lake-Grandy Lake Road. In 12.5 miles, just after crossing the Rocky Creek Bridge, turn left onto Loomis-Nooksack Road #12. At 1.8 miles keep straight and at 3.6 miles turn right onto Sulphur Creek Road #13 for 6 miles to road end. The trail head is west of the road near the outhouse.
